My name is Gina (44) and i live in Belgium, near Maastricht. We've got two dogs, Sara and Sascha whom we have found a few years ago, there were 4 dogs then. Sascha, the mother, 2 pups (Sara and Nanda) and the father Bob who sadly died in the Flemish shelter (put to sleep). We initially had only taken Sara and someone else had adopted Sascha, but they brought her back to the shelter because they said she'd bitten a child. I read about this on the shelter's website, about 5 and a half months later and had to go there, afraid they might put her to sleep as well, like they had done with Bob. A few days before this, I had found the people who adopted Sara's sister Nanda and we had agreed on a reunion. Little did we know, Sascha would also be included! I didn't know how fast i had to get her out of the shelter. When i walked Sascha to the car, she jumped in the front seat and rolled on her back with her feet in the air, her paws into my direction and with a smiling face, as if she said 'THANK YOU'. My heart cried at that moment and i knew i did the right thing.
